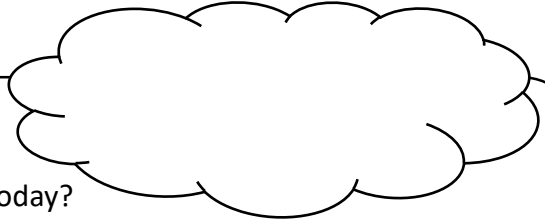
Collect some information:
